## **Minutes of the 2012 AGM / AGA 2012**

Present in person at the 2012 AGM were CEC President David Ogborn (DO), as well as CEC members Kevin Austin (KA), Darren Copeland (DC), Richard Henninger (RH), Emilie LeBel (EB), Michael Palumbo (MP), Sarah Peebles (SP) and Nadene Thériault-Copeland (NTC). CEC Administrative co-Director jef chippewa (JC) listened/participated via Skype.

The meeting began at 17:05, Saturday, 18 August 2012. Kevin Austin presided over the meeting. CEC Administrative co-Director jef chippewa acted as Secretary for the meeting.

### **Ordre du jour / Agenda**

#### **1. Adoption of the agenda / Approbation de l'ordre du jour**

KA reads the Agenda and requests a motion to adopt the Agenda. The Agenda is adopted by consensus.

#### **2. Adoption of the minutes of the previous AGM / Approbation du procès-verbal de la dernière AGA**

The Minutes in the documentation are presented. KA moves to adopt the Minutes. The Minutes were adopted by consensus.

#### **3. Business arising from the minutes of the previous AGM / Sujets touchant le procès-verbal de la dernière AGA**

There were no items arising from the Minutes of the 2011 AGM.

#### **4. President's Report / Rapport du Président**

DO gives a summary of his President's Report to those present, and also mentions that the current year (2012–13) will be his last year as President.

KA moves to accept the President's Report. The President's Report was adopted by consensus.

## **5. Reports from the Board / Rapports du Conseil d'Administration**

Kevin Austin reads the Treasurer's Report / Rapport du Trésorier submitted by the CEC's Treasurer, Eldad Tsabary, who could not be present for the meeting. Brief explanations and clarifications of some of the budget lines were given by KA and JC following questions by DC and SP.

KA requests a motion to adopt the Treasurer's Report. There were no objections. The Treasurer's Report was adopted by consensus.

## **6. Other business / Autres**

- Vote on the creation of "CEC Council" and to accept small related modifications and translation corrections to the [CEC Bylaws §6](#)

DO gives a summary of the bylaws and changes proposed to them that were tabled at the 2011 AGM. A discussion of the implications and the benefits of the CEC Council to the Board and to the CEC's activities ensued.

A motion was made by KA to vote to approve the changes and the establishment of the CEC Council. Seconded by RH. The item was adopted by consensus.

SP brought up the development of SONUS as streaming. Discussion about royalties and the changing implications of streaming, narrowcasting etc. and downloading ensued. NTC provided background on NAISA's experiences in these areas.

MP suggests incorporating an option for TES participants being able to become a CEC member during the registration process for the symposium; a brief discussion ensues.

## **7. Adjournment / Levée de l'assemblée**

DO requests a motion to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned by consensus at 18:10, Saturday, 18 August 2012, in Artscape Wychwood Barns' NAISA Studio, Toronto.

- Changes in laws relating to non-profit organizations and the impact of these changes on the CEC Bylaws

### **Executive Summary**

The CEC bylaws are being modified to conform with new government regulations. The changes are:

1. Notice of the Annual General Meeting will be given at least 21 days before the meeting;
2. The annual Financial Report will be sent to voting members at least 21 days before the meeting;
3. Due to the addition of a new bylaw, §8.3, the subsequent subsections of Section 8 will be renumbered.

### **6.1 Proposed Changes to the CEC Bylaws**

Altered or deleted text is underlined in the first version; the new version with changes in bold follows.

### **6.4 Minutes of the Preliminary General Meeting on 15 August 2013 to Discuss Changes to the CEC Bylaws**

Present in person at the September 15, 2013 Preliminary General Meeting were CEC President David Ogborn (DO), CEC Vice-President Eldad Tsabary (ET) and CEC Administrative co-Director jef chippewa (JC), CEC members Kevin Austin (KA), Jean-François Denis (JFD), James Harley (JH) and Richard Henninger (RH), as well as guest Monica Pearse from the Canadian League of Composers.

The meeting began at 17:15 on Thursday, 15 August 2013. CEC President David Ogborn presided over the meeting. CEC Administrative co-Director jef chippewa acted as Secretary for the meeting.

DO opened the meeting and explained the reason for holding the meeting. JC then gave an overview of the changes required (see §6.1–6.3, above), emphasizing that the CEC bylaws, written by KA and JFD in 1984–85 prior to the founding of the association, were so foresighted that only very small, essentially cosmetic changes are necessary to the existing bylaws.

JC gave an overview of the situation regarding the new Not-for-profit Corporations Act, a set of rules that replace the old Canada Corporations Act. JC explained AGM Agenda item 6.1 (proposed changes). JC explained Agenda item 6.2 (new bylaw). KA filled in some details of the changes relating to the voting membership (§6.2, above) based on his reading of the documents provided by Industry Canada. JC explained Agenda item 6.3 (renumbering of §8 of the CEC Bylaws).

RH moved to table the matter for vote at the upcoming AGM. ET seconded the movement. Adopted by consensus.

JC thanked KA for his attentive reading of the government documents and analysing and proposing the changes needed to bring the CEC's bylaws in synch with the new government guidelines.

KA gave a little more background on the mechanisms of the government's move to oblige not-for-profit associations in Canada to update their bylaws.

JFD moved to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned by consensus at 17:27 on Thursday, 15 August 2013.

#### 1) \$19,100 deducted from overall balance as of 31 May 2013 (see p. 2)

Over the past decade, due to changing fiscal accounting procedures, the Canada Council for the Arts' Writing & Publishing grant has moved out of sync with the CEC's fiscal year, due to some minor but ongoing errors, which has resulted in the desynchronizing of the reporting of income and expenses in the annual Financial Statements.

The CEC's accountant has therefore recommended that this issue be resolved in this fiscal year. This is reflected in the Financial Statement of 2012–13 (which will be presented at the 2013 AGM), and specific details of this will be distributed to the membership in September 2013.

#### 2) Accounts Payable

The amount includes the pressing / distribution of Cache 2010 and 2011, ads to be placed in magazines and outstanding payments for eContact! vol. 14.x (2012–13).

#### 1) Déduction de 19 100 \$ du solde total du 31 mai 2013 (voir p. 2)

Dû à des changements dans les procédures de comptabilité, la bourse attribuée par la section Littérature du Conseil des arts du Canada se trouve depuis près d'une décennie à ne plus être synchronisée avec l'année fiscale de la CEC. Des erreurs mineures mais continues ont contribué à la « désynchronisation » des rapports de revenus et dépenses détaillés dans les États financiers annuels.

La comptable de la CEC a donc recommandé que ce problème soit corrigé pour la fin de cette année fiscale. Cette correction se trouve dans les États financiers pour 2012–13 (présentés lors de l'AGM 2013).
